

## CHS 2024-2025 PAID CLASS BEHAVIORAL GUIDELINES AND FACILITY POLICIES

All CHS participants are guests of CBC, with access only to those areas that have been approved by CBC for a set day, time, and room. Only CBC adults and students can be elsewhere during class time and only for church business. Students **MUST** be accompanied by a CBC adult. The following is not exhaustive. If you have questions concerning CHS policy, please ask a teacher, TA, monitor, or CHS leadership team. Students shall be committed to and able to comply with the following:

### GENERAL

- Clothing, make-up, hair styles, and jewelry are to be modest, in good taste, or in no way distracting or attention drawing. Rule of thumb: if you have to ask, change. If necessary, a student can be asked to go home and change.
- When not in class (layovers, early dismissal, lunch, etc.) students must be in the classroom that they just finished or in the lunchroom.
- Students are expected to help carry supplies to and from the parking lot as needed and to set up/break down classrooms as directed.
- Students are not to wait alone in the parking lot for their rides: phones and windows can be used to know when a ride has arrived.
- Internet use is for necessary communication and information.

### CLASSROOM

- Students are expected to manifest an attitude of honor, respect, cooperation, and positive participation.
- Each Student is responsible to consistently attend class and complete all assigned work according to schedule for each class in which he/she is enrolled unless other arrangements have been made with the instructor.
- Classroom etiquette is to be observed: paying attention, no talking, raising hands to speak, answering when spoken to, no interrupting, remaining seated unless otherwise instructed, asking permission to leave the room (including restroom), not leaving until the class is dismissed **and** the room is in order.
- Students are expected to be in their seat when their class is scheduled to begin.
- It is the responsibility of each student to notify the instructor if he/she will be absent, to obtain assignments/notes/lab assignments, and to make up any work missed according to the deadline and manner prescribed by the teacher.
- Student phones are to be turned off/silent during class: **absolutely no texting, calls, or checking messages during class**. At the discretion of the teacher, a student may receive a zero or be asked to leave the room if this takes place during a test or lecture.

### DISCIPLINE

When a student is disruptive in class, disrespectful of an instructor or the assistant, in any way physically or verbally harmful to anyone, or found not abiding by the guidelines and policies listed above, the following disciplinary steps will be taken: **first offense**, a verbal warning, immediate change expected and required; **second offense**, parental notification with practical resolution; **third offense**, expulsion from CHS classes. If the original offense is severe enough, expulsion will be immediate.

## FACILITIES

It is expected that everyone who uses CBC facilities will take great care to keep them in the best possible condition. Please note: **These rules are in place for the protection of CHS, its students, and its teachers.**

- Students are to stay **only** in areas assigned to their activities: second floor classrooms, rest rooms and drinking faucet.
- Students and teachers are to use the main entrance, main stairs, and elevator unless otherwise directed.
- Students must stay out of the Gym unless directed by a teacher.
- All CHS activities must be supervised at all times by adults; **make sure there is an adult in class when you drop off your student.**
- Nuts and Peanuts are **NOT** permitted in the building. Red drinks are **NOT** permitted in the building – even if they're in the machine.
- Church supplies are **NOT** to be used by CHS: paper, pencils, tape, glue, cups, napkins, etc. Never is the copy machine to be used.
- At the end of the last class, all tables and chairs must be returned to where they were at the beginning of the day, chairs pushed under the tables, tables cleaned, church equipment returned to its proper location, trash taken out, dry erase boards cleaned, carpet vacuumed if necessary, etc. **Our policy is to leave everything in better shape than we found it.**
- When trash is taken out, liners should be replaced, and the trash taken **to** and placed **in** the dumpster in the parking lot.
- Only authorized adults are permitted to use any electronics **or** move the dividing walls.
- In the event anything is broken, the church office is to be informed right away.
- Speed is to be kept to a proper limit in the parking lot by students as well as their family members (siblings).
- No skateboards, scooters, bicycles, etc. allowed on campus.
